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# Aphasia Research Study

**Purpose of research study:** To explore stress, mood, and speech therapy experiences of stroke survivors with aphasia, especially Black/African American stroke survivors with aphasia.

**To be included in this study,** you must meet the following criteria:

- Experienced stroke at least 6 months ago
- Have a diagnosis of aphasia
- Have participated in speech therapy
- Speak English as a primary language
- Be at least 21 years old
- Have at least an 8<sup>th</sup> grade education

Because part of this study is online (using Zoom), participants will need...

- A computer or tablet

Time commitment: 1-2 hours over 1-2 sessions

Compensation: \$10 gift card for each completed session

Research activities: **All participants** will complete a 1-hour session:

- questionnaire about you (age, education, stroke date)
- a brief language comprehension test
- several short questionnaires (stress, mood, speech therapy)

**Black/African American participants** will be invited to also complete:

- a 1-hour interview about their speech therapy experiences
- caregiver may be included as needed

Location of research study: online/Zoom video conferencing; interview via Zoom or phone.

Benefits: **This study is not clinical care**, but will help us develop aphasia treatment research.
