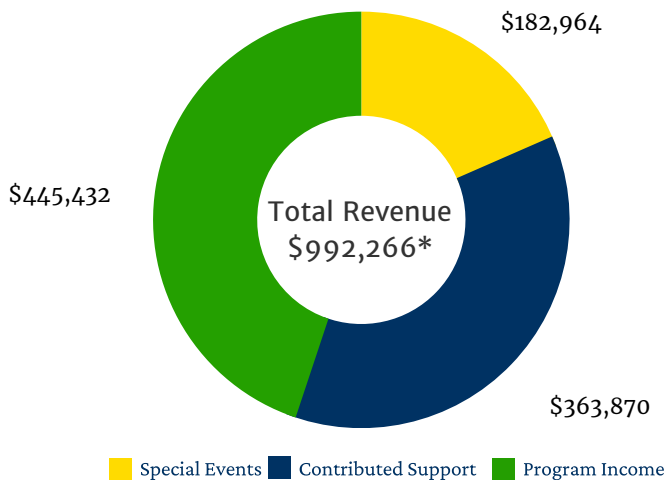

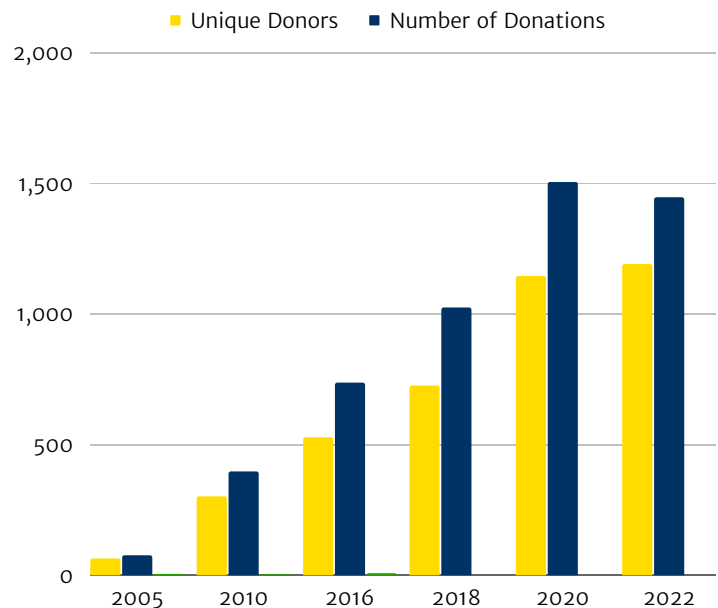

Program tuition makes up less than half of our total income. We count on donors to keep our programs running and our doors open!

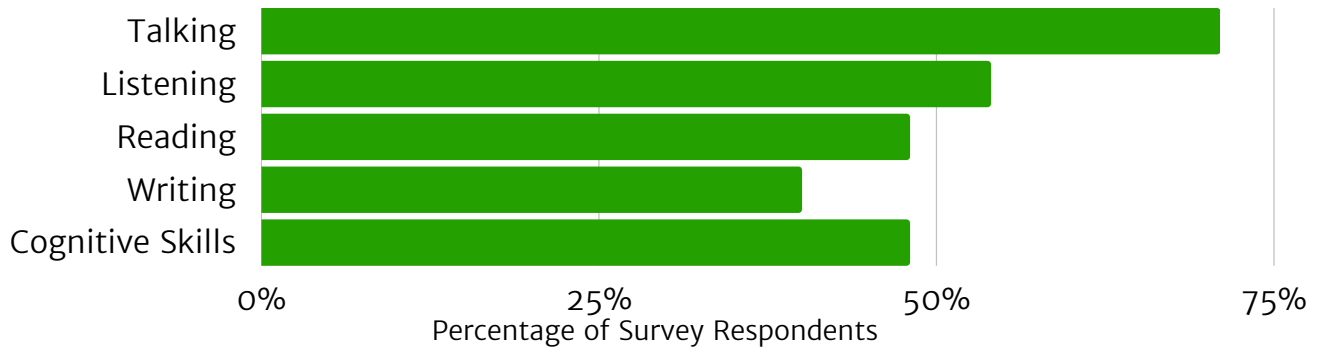

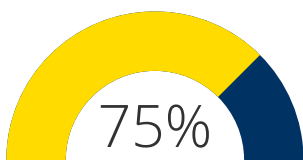

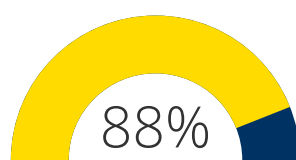

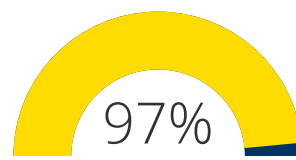

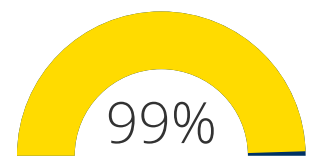
